#### IN PRESENCE AND ONLINE



Replicating the experience of the last edition, the event will take place in-person on the Lungolago Gonzaga in Mantova and will maintain, amplified, the international dimension acquired in the 2021, 2022 and 2023 editions held within the global network of the GLOBE Program (<a href="www.globe.gov">www.globe.gov</a>), in collaboration with the GLOBE Europe-Eurasia Region Coordination Office.

Therefore, schools will be able to participate face-to-face, holding activities (monitoring labs, scientific demonstrations, creative activities, etc.), or visiting the activities proposed by others, but also online, presenting e-products, or watching live. Schools that present face-to-face or online activities will be issued a certificate of active participation.

The workstation face to face activities will begin lakeside at **9:00 AM** and will end at **1:00 PM CET**; as per tradition, some classes will continue the activities lakeside or in the city.

The online activities will start at 9:30 AM and will end at 12:30 PM CET.



#### THE EVENT IN PRESENCE

As per the twenty-year tradition, the event will take place in the splendid setting of the Mantova lakes. The workstations will be located along the Lungolago Gonzaga, between nature and culture: facing the waters of the River Mincio and backed by the magnificent monuments of medieval Mantova.

- A- Schools that will manage face-to-face activities
- B- Schools that will participate as visitors

On **March 10**<sup>th</sup>, they will receive the logistical and organizational information useful for reaching the venue of the event and for activating their workstations. On **March 15**<sup>th</sup> they will receive the Agenda.

Note: We have decided not to include the registration links for foreign schools for on site participation due to the high costs that it would entail. But if any European school would like to join us in this circumstance, they would be extremely welcome.

#### THE ONLINE EVENT - REGISTRATION FORM



Two online live broadcasts will be structured: one at an international level, in English, managed by researchers from Deakin University, A/Prof. Ass. Alessandra Sutti and Env. Eng. Stuart Robottom; one at a national level, in Italian, managed by the GLOBE Italia Team in collaboration with high school students in Mantova. The international live broadcast will be structured around live or pre-recorded interventions by teachers, scientists from universities, research institutions and GLOBE and non-GLOBE agencies from Italy, Europe-Eurasia, Asia and Pacific, North and South America; the national live broadcast of the event will be structured on connections from Lungolago Gonzaga and from some Italian, European and Asian locations and on the broadcast of national and international recorded materials.

- Drawings or pictures with captions: please insert captions and other written directly in English

#### 3. Dimensions and Format of Materials

#### **VIDEO**

- 1. Max 2 minutes and 100 MB
- 2. Format MP4

**Recommendation:** if the videos are shot with a **smartphone**, **shoot with the largest dimension of the device in a horizontal position** 

#### **PRESENTATION**

1. Max 2 minutes and 100 MB in format .ppt o video MP4. If in .ppt, the presentation must run automatically with embedded audio commentar.
